The owner of the farm in question has some health issues, in addition to his age no longer allowing him to do the day-to-day chores on the farm. Due to his failing health, his daughter had little choice but to move him to an assisted living facility. This gentleman has fed his barn cats and cared for them for many years. However, he neglected to have the cats spayed/neutered. Today, there are approximately 100 cats living on the property!

The gentleman's daughter resides in Texas. She has put her life on hold and has spent the winter in Kansas caring for these cats. She desperately needs our help! The farm is to be sold, and there will be no one living on the property to care for the cats.

Through a combined efforts of Best Friends Animal Society, Cat Care Network, and Friends of Felines, our plan is to Trap-Neuter and relocate these cats to new areas with managed care.
